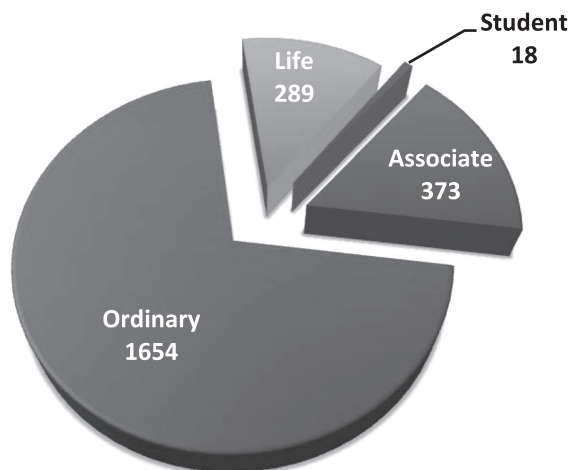

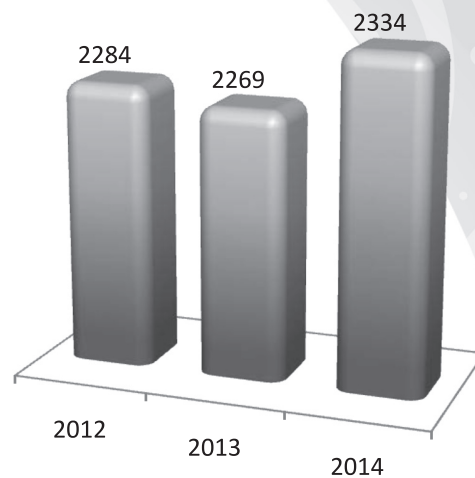

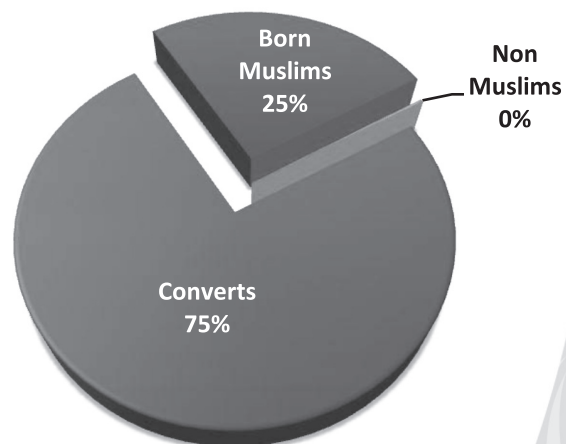
Membership in 2014

Membership Breakdown



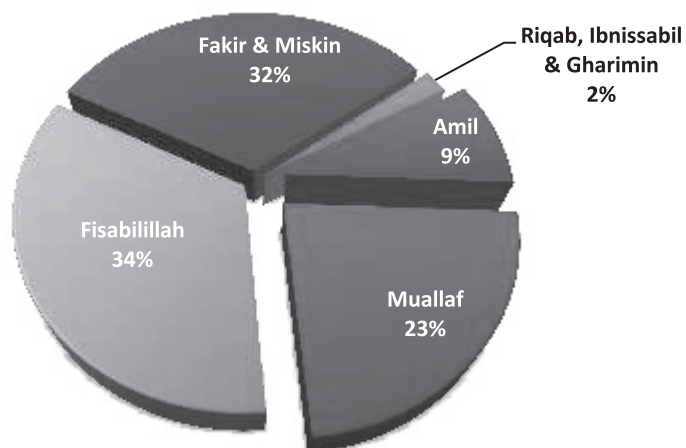

One-Stop Centre for Converts (OSCC)

In 2014, MCAS as a One-Stop Centre for Converts continued to facilitate the issuance of the following:



- Conversion Card
- Conversion Kit
- Reimbursements of fees for
 - o transport
 - o circumcision
 - o charges incurred upon insertion of Muslim name in identity card for Singaporeans

All Converts were encouraged to attend the Knowing Islam Session, Beginners' Course in Islam and Solat Tutorial prior to making an appointment for conversion.

On the day of conversion, the Converts were personally invited to participate in the upcoming activities and attend the talks that would be organised by MCAS. This is part of the efforts to build a strong relationship with the Converts as well as encouraging them to continue attending more classes that are made available for them in MCAS.

PASTORAL CARE PROGRAMME (PCP)

The Pastoral Care Programme (PCP) is dedicated to establish a buddy system for the Converts. A volunteer, known as the Befriender, is assigned to a new Convert to facilitate the Convert's journey as a new Muslim. The volunteer serves as the bridge that extends the Converts to the established resources of MCAS including: educational services, social events, financial assistance, counselling services, enrichment programmes, legal advice, etc. In the long run, we hope these Converts will return to support the other new Converts in future.

In 2014, a total of 503 (70%) out of 712 converts opted to be in the PCP.

8 and 21 May – Befrienders Recruitment Briefing & Training. The PCP had about 190 volunteers, including 70 Converts, actively participating in the programme.

25 October – A Welcome to Islam Gathering Session was conducted for the new Muslims. A total of 75 people (about 30 Converts) came to the session including their partners and some volunteers. The programme included a short presentation on Converts' Development Division, workflow and discussion about the challenges for Converts.

8 November – The 'In Conversation' programme was organised for Converts to learn from Shaykh Afeefuddin Al-Jailani. Participants were encouraged to share their experiences and ask the scholar on any relevant issues. About 80 people, including 50 Converts, turned up for this session in the Auditorium.

29 November – A total of 80 people (including 35 Converts) came for a Strategic Meeting to launch the Converts Clustering Project (under the PCP). Participants were divided into 7 groups based on the location of their residences. They discussed ideas on programmes to activate the *silaturahmi* (bonds of friendship) initiatives. The volunteers responded positively to implement the programmes at the cluster level. New Befrienders were also provided training on how to approach and communicate with new Muslims.

Frequency: Single session
(Every Weekend except Public Holidays)

Duration: 2.5 hours

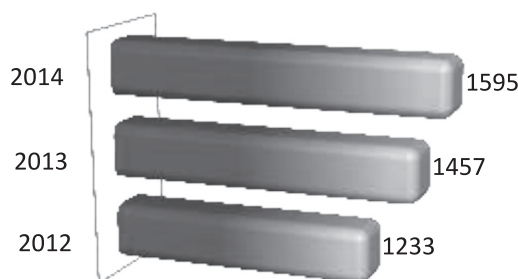

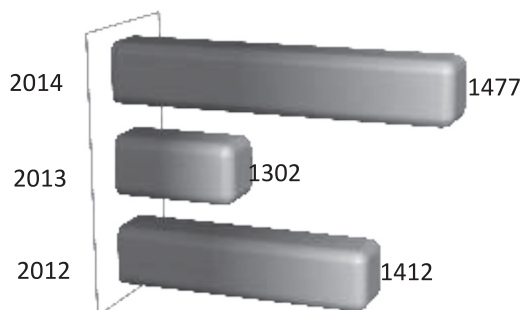

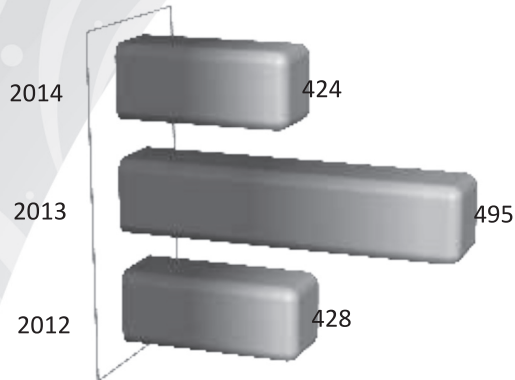

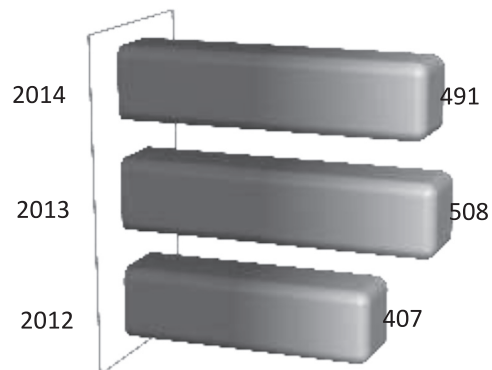

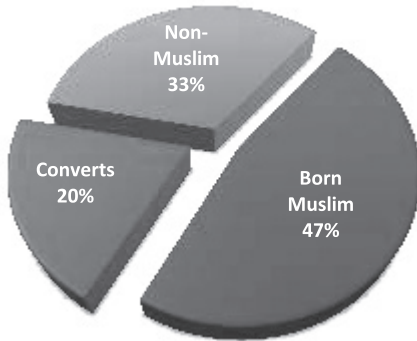

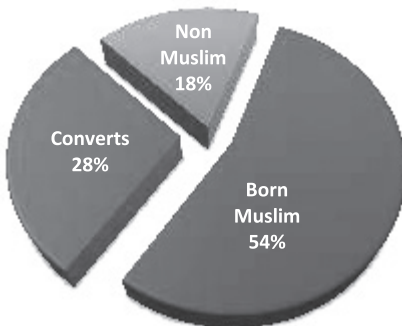

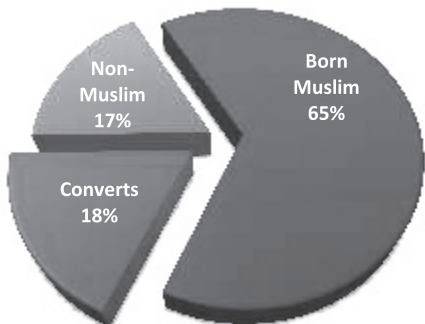

MARRIAGE GUIDANCE COURSE (MGC)

Frequency: 2 Sunday sessions / 1 weekday session (Express)

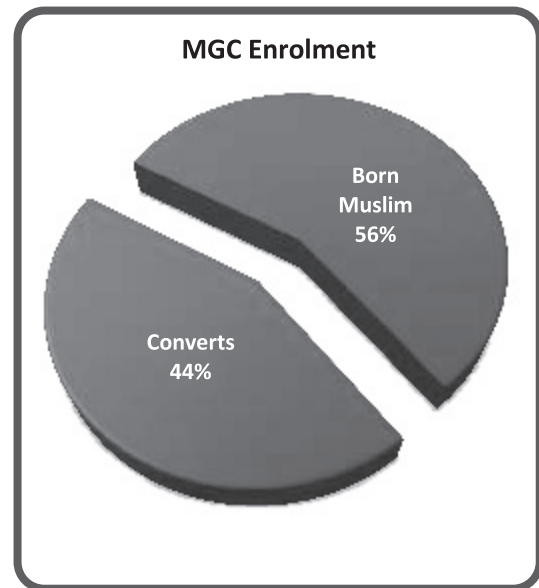
Time: 9.30am – 6.00pm

Description: The course offers converts and their partners marriage guidance and prepares them for their new roles and lives in new families. The express course met demands of those who were on a short stay in Singapore or work on Sundays.

No. of Cycles: 24 (MGC & MGCX)

Total Participants: 418

MCAS is constantly in communication with the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF) in its efforts to improve the course.



COURSES @ EXTERNAL VENUES

Education Division held some courses at selected local mosques to make our classes more accessible for students, especially Converts, staying in the Western and Northern parts of Singapore.

Education Division conducted religious classes in English at three mosques:

- 1) Masjid Al Iman (North-West)
- 2) Masjid Al Khair (Central-West)
- 3) Masjid Darussalam (South-West)

Through this initiative, 12 courses have been successfully organised throughout the year, reaching out to 254 students.

RAMADHAN CAMPAIGN

Collaborating with Majlis Ugama Islam Singapore (MUIS), Education Division participated in the Ramadhan Campaign by organising Solat Refresher Courses at three mosques and at MCAS, reaching out to 300 students.

PERSONAL COACHING

The Individual Personal Coaching (IPC) is provided for students who had irregular working hours, travelled frequently, and required a language other than English as the medium of instruction, or were on a very short stay in Singapore. The IPC is conducted at the mutual convenience of the teacher and the student. In 2014, 205 students had been assigned a teacher for IPC.

TOWER OF LOVE PART 1 / 2

This programme helped participants to rekindle the passion in their marriage and introduced the fundamentals towards amplifying their love, simplifying their differences and applications on how to strengthen their bond. This year, 15 couples attended the programme on 15 February, 8 March, 7 June and 29 November.

LOVE & ENLIGHTENMENT

The programme was formerly known as “Converts’ In-Laws Support Programme”. There were 30 participants (couples with their families) who attended this workshop that guided them through concerns in inter-racial marriage. They learnt to understand and respect family culture, upbringing and traditions, as well as customs of their partners’ and families, as Islam celebrates diversity and mutual love.

PARA-COUNSELLING WORKSHOP (BASIC / ADVANCE)

This interactive workshop provided theoretical and practical tips on how to be an effective communicator. Ust Saif-ur-Rahman conducted the workshop for 150 participants, half of whom were Converts. Other participants included students, befrienders and volunteers, who gained knowledge on effective questioning skills, emphatic listening abilities as well as proper articulation of situational responses. The workshop were conducted on 21 March, 18 October and 20 December.

SHARI’AH LAW WORKSHOP

The Shari’ah Law Workshop was held in two parts. Ust Saif-ur-Rahman shared his experiences from working in the Shariah Court and covered topics within the public and private aspects of life that were regulated in a legal system based on Islam. 220 participants had attended the workshop on 11 and 19 April, 7 November and 27 December.

FARAI DH WORKSHOP

This workshop is organised to provide participants with an understanding on the distribution of wealth, or *Faraidh*, that stipulated how the estate of a Muslim is to be distributed after their death (in the event that the Muslim pass away intestate). Ust Khairani Basiron had conducted the workshop for 60 participants (25 Converts) on 26 April, 23 August and 13 December.

INTERNALISING & UNDERSTANDING ISLAM

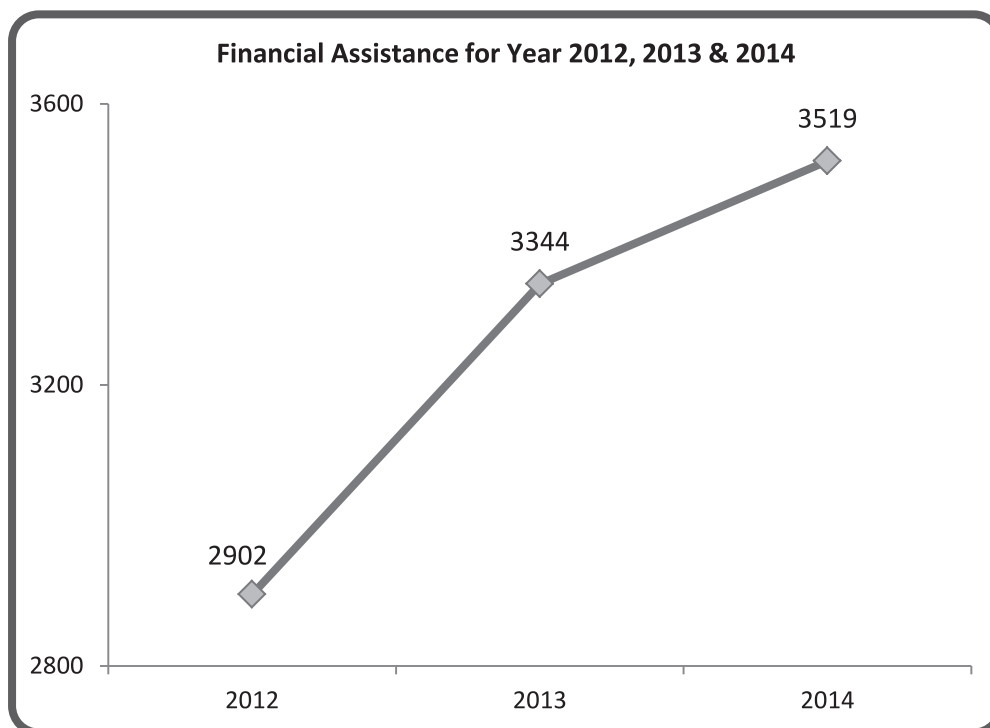
Da'wah Division also digitised the archive of lectures by invited speakers of the MCAS. There were 992 VHS tapes that were converted into DVDs and digital copy in July.

On 20 July, the yearly *Zakat* Disbursement was conducted, benefiting 562 families each receiving \$265 in cash and \$40 in NTUC vouchers. A total of \$171,410 was distributed (\$148,930 from Zakat funds and \$22,480 from Fidyah).
